ACTION

1.0	<u>WELCOME:</u> The meeting was opened with a welcome from JW	
2.0	<u>APOLOGIES:</u> May Burns Councillor John Ferguson(JF)	
3.0	<u>POLICE REPORT</u> from PC Ross Brierley, Irvine Police Station Anti-social behaviour of youths has been the main focus in Kilwinning – with underage drinking and licensed premises being closely monitored. Increase in car crime particularly in the Pennyburn area, where police are working closely with Community Wardens. There have been no reported problems at the new allotments. JW asked about traffic management in the Main Street – this is still a problem. JK asked about the safety of the path leading to Dalry Road and asked for a presence from the police on this path.	
4.0	<u>MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING – 20th SEPTEMBER 2012</u> Minute note – Andrew Chamberlain should have been included as present at meeting. Approved by Stephanie Krus, seconded by Jim Kennedy	
5.0 5.1	<u>MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES</u> <u>Footpath at Dalry Road</u> – SK gave an update – extended 30mph signs are now in use. Some clearing of vegetation has taken place. West side of path is under the maintenance of factors Hacking & Paterson - property manager Craig Cosgrove is awaiting estimate of cost for temporary repairs. Still unclear who owns east side running from railway to Dalry Road. JF & RS have contacted a number of departments within NAC with regards to path. The path has been designated as a ‘shortest safest road to school’ by the transport department at NAC. Tim Swan and The Parent Council at Kilwinning Academy are concerned about the path – they are in touch with Fiona Cameron NAC who provided Travel Plan – awaiting response. Still not clear who might pay for lighting – RS commented that NAC have agreed to plans for a Safe & Secure North Ayrshire – has agreed to progress.	RS

Has there been a lack of expertise within the development? What is the position with the car park? Eglinton Park is a great asset to Kilwinning and we have no desire to see this development threaten the look and value of the park. A visit from KCC to the site would be welcome to answer these questions and allay fears. There has been a lack of communication from NAC with these residents despite requests for a consultation with NAC & Network Rail.</p> <p>Issues raised – Resident’s Parking; Traffic Management & Safety; Security; Volume of contractor vehicles; Lack of notification to neighbourhood; No proposal to upgrade surrounding roads.</p> <p>Meeting agreed to write to Angus Brodie – roads department NAC requesting a meeting with all concerned – Residents/NAC/Network Rail/Police/KCC</p>	<p>JG</p>

Noted that NAC’s strategy for play parks was not clear.
