Nairn has asked for support from KCC. Lack of funds in the Project Account prohibits KCC from offering financial help, but individuals may wish to help in some way on the night. JG to seek clarification from Nairn as to how we can help.  Concern was raised re the safety of the venue and close proximity to housing. All agreed that an organised display would be welcomed in the town.	JG

9.4	BT expressed a concern on recent news items that car parking costs may be brought into Kilwinning. All agreed that this could be detrimental to the town – forcing people to go elsewhere. It may be preferable to have a period of time that is free – but all day parking should be discouraged. Agreed that a 3 hour slot would be acceptable – concerns will be raised with NAC.	JG
9.5	BT expressed concern over caravan area in Eglinton Park - asked Councillor Steel if it was possible for the rules of hiring camping pitches to be tightened up in respect to commercial vehicles and travellers. Councillor Steel will investigate.	RS
