9	Community Councillors: MS enquired about the land at the railway station previously occupied by Hay & Anderson and potential for commercial use. JW commented on the poor state of paths in Eglinton Park and the unsightly nature of the housing development next to the stable block. BK The Segdoune Queen and attendants enjoyed a very successful visit to the Abbey Clock Tower and Old Parish Church at Doors Open weekend. Promoting Kilwinning is working with local businesses to promote an Elf competition during the Christmas Lights switch-on, 21 st November. Replacement lights will cost £20,000. There will be a real tree this year. Fairtrade re-accreditation is underway. The clean-up campaign is about to start. JH raised an issue about dog fouling and it was agreed to contact the NAC officer for assistance and attending a future KCC meeting.
